<p><b>Learning Objective</b></p> <p>Explain how and why various land-based empires <u>developed and expanded</u> from 1450 to 1750.</p>	<p><b>Historical Developments</b></p> <p>Imperial expansion relied on the increased use of gunpowder, cannons, and armed trade to establish large empires in both hemispheres.</p> <p>Land empires included the <u>Manchu</u> in Central and East Asia; the <u>Mughal</u> in South and Central Asia; the <u>Ottoman</u> in Southern Europe, the Middle East, and North Africa; and the <u>Safavids</u> in the Middle East.</p> <p>Political and religious disputes led to rivalries and conflict between states.</p> <p>State rivalries:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Safavid-Mughal conflict</li> <li>• Songhai Empire's conflict with Morocco</li> </ul>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>1. Explain how the land-based empires of the 1450-1750 time period developed (what allowed them to obtain and maintain power):</b> <p>The expansion of trade and exploration. Utilized advanced military strategies and technology to conquer new territories. They also relied on the increased use of gunpowder.</p> </li> <li><b>2. Describe the Qing Dynasty (use SPICE-T characteristics):</b> <p>Last imperial dynasty, rejected a maritime empire, built a massive land empire using powerful technology and access to resources to expand, did not seek to assimilate conquered people, showed respect for cultures, patriarchal society, new silver supplies helped economy, population surpassed food supply, rigid social structure.</p> </li> <li><b>3. Describe the Mughal Empire (use SPICE-T characteristics):</b> <p>Muslim state - dominance over most of India in the sixteenth and seventeenth centuries, relied on gunpowder weapons and tax farming for political power, controlled commercial networks based on cotton, indigo, and silk, religious conflicts permeated society, land revenue granted to military and gov't officials in exchange for service, patriarchal, child marriage common</p> </li> <li><b>4. Describe the Ottoman Empire (use SPICE-T characteristics):</b> <p>relied on gunpowder weapons and tax farming for political power, the largest and most enduring of the great Islamic empires of the time period, women had political/legal rights, Ottoman rulers grew paranoid and killed any potential ruler who was too powerful-led to weak rulers</p> </li> <li><b>5. Describe the Safavid Empire (use SPICE-T characteristics)</b> <p>relied on gunpowder weapons for political power, came into conflict with the Ottomans as they expanded, Sunni Shi'ite split, mixture of Turkish and Persian culture, economy negatively impacted by inflation caused by flood of silver, women were permitted to participate in society, but were veiled and restricted in movement; had rights to inheritance and divorce, rebellion led to chaos in centralization and tax collection.</p> </li> </ol>
